


Humanity is Every One Person (HEOP) and its sponsor Brahmankyrie, together with Eastlake Church, was in collaboration with RJ Donovan Community Resource Department in organizing and bringing forth the first ever, three day Restorative Justice Fair on Facility E on August 23rd, 24th & 25th 2019.

This fair consisted of multiple healing groups throughout the weekend. A Remorse Processing Workshop was conducted with Dr Greenwald, Chief of Mental Health. There was a Restorative Justice Connecting circle with Khemal Johnson Williams for the DA's office. Dr Andrea Travers from Victims Offenders Education Group talked about remorse, empathy and the healing process culminating on the final day with a forgiveness meditation lead by Brahmankyrie from the Brahman Project and her team. There were also many other various organizations that had their booths set up to represent the institution and the community of San Diego County. These booths included Alternative to Violence and "South West College to name a few.

Speakers who appeared for the fair included Marissa Bejarano from the DA's office, Kanten Russell pro skater, Essie from Mothers with a Message as well as current and former Facility E Captains. Overall there were over fifty volunteers/guest speakers/contributors from the San Diego Community.

Mr Vaughn is commended for his outstanding leadership role in creating, planning and organizing all activities during this, first ever, three day Restorative Justice Fair. As founder and President of HEOP he was vital to all aspects of the creative process for this fair and worked well in collaboration with his team members to execute a cohesive and well-organized event.
